
Ark Encounter & Philadelphia Trip Plans Completed Reservations are Open-Call Now!




Historic Philadelphia, 2022

Trip cost includes round trip air via American Airlines, 3 nights at the Penn's View Hotel, and a two day Sightseeing pass with a one-day Hop-On/Hop Off pass. The Sightseeing pass includes free admission to over 35 tours and museums.

Philadelphia is home to many national historical sites that relate to the founding of the United States. Independence National Historical Park is the center of these historical landmarks. Independence Hall, where the Declaration of Independence was signed, and the Liberty Bell are the city's most famous attractions. Other national historic sites include the homes of Edgar Allan Poe and Thaddeus Kosciuszko, early government buildings like the First and Second Banks of the United States, Fort Mifflin, and the Gloria Dei (Old Swedes') Church. Philadelphia alone has 67 National Historic Landmarks, the third most of any city in the country.



Travel Tips (for people who travel cheap)

Some airlines have changed the size for carry-on baggage. Soon all airlines will require this size. If your luggage is several years old your carry-on may be to big!

When you are ready to book your flight compare total cost. Some airlines have free carry-on while others have a fee (usually around \$25) or require all luggage to be checked. Checked luggage is around \$30.00 for 1st bag and more for the 2nd. So, if you are traveling with family be sure to check one bag per person or you will pay extra.

Your personal item must be small enough to fit under the seat. A purse, brief case, backpack and some very small suitcases are allowed.

Remember, liquids must be in 3oz containers or less. If it's more, they will remove it from your carry-on. Sharp objects are not allowed. This even includes finger nail files!

You may carry larger bottles of liquids and some sharp objects in your checked luggage.
